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Strategies on How to Ensure Affordable, High-Quality Renal Replacement Therapy (RRT) in the Future



The prevalence of chronic kidney disease is still increasing. The reasons are manifold: people are becoming older, and loss of renal function is also a symptom of old age. Yet demographic trends alone do not explain the upward trend in chronic kidney disease (CKD); other common causes of CKD are diabetes mellitus, hypertension, smoking, and obesity – and it is known that the prevalence of these conditions is still rising. In addition, survival of kidney patients becomes longer. Therefore experts suggest that the number of people with limited kidney function may still increase in the next decades.
